RESULTS

Overall Points will be awarded for each class

5 points for first, 3 points for second, 1 point for third

The exhibitor gaining the most points will win a DIPLOMA from the Worshipful Company of Gardeners, provided that the entry includes at least ONE FIRST PLACE

Multiple entries allowed in all classes for different types and coloured varieties

All exhibits (except class 13) to be grown by the exhibitor

CLASSES

TRUMPET DAFFODILS

1. One Vase 3 Blooms Long Trumpet daffodils Any Colour
(Trumpet as long or longer than the petals)

NARCISSI

2. One vase 3 stems Large Cupped Narcissi any colour
(cup more than one third, less than or equal to the length of the petals)
3. One vase 3 stems Small Cupped Narcissi Any Colour
(cup not more than one third of the length of the petals)
4. One vase 3 stems Double Narcissi any colour
5. One vase 3 stems any other Daffodil/Narcissi any colour
6. One vase 3 stems Miniature Daffodil/Narcissi any colour

OTHERS

7. Eight heads of Hellebore single or mixed colours in a shallow bowl
8. One vase 3 Tulips any variety/colour
9. One vase 3 stems Primula any colour
10. One vase Spring Flowers outdoor grown
11. 3 sprays from a flowering shrub outdoor grown
12. One vase 3 stems any flower not included in above

FLOWER ARRANGEMENT

13. One arrangement of Spring Flowers (flowers can be purchased)

POT PLANTS AND BULBS

14. One Non-Flowering Pot Plant
15. One Flowering Pot Plant
16. One Cactus or Succulent Plant
17. One bowl or pot of any bulbous plant/s

CHILDRENS (Age 12 or under)

18. A posy of Spring Flowers

19. Photograph 'Spring has Sprung'
20. 6 small cakes for Afternoon Tea (Can be all the same or Variety)
